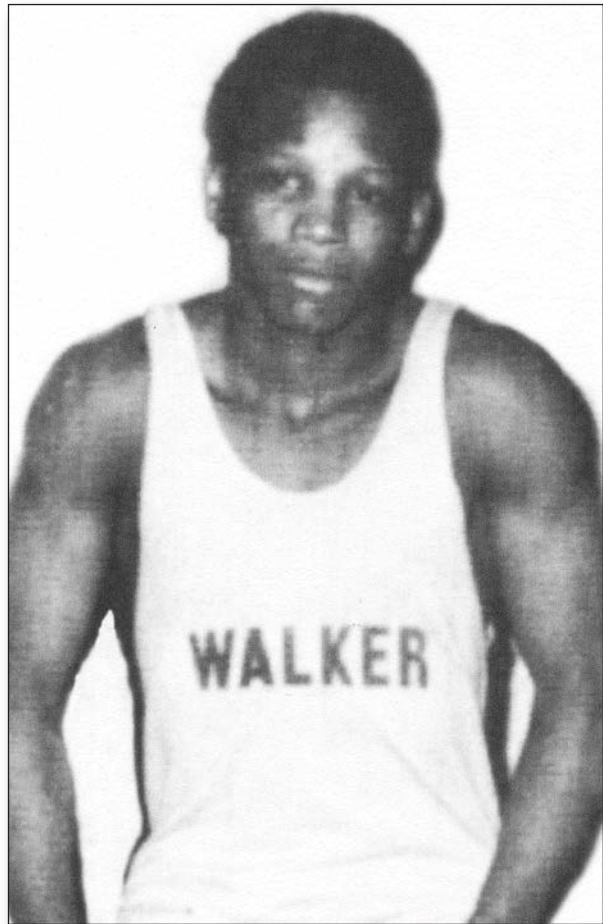


BOBBY COLBERT

Bobby was the captain of the 1972 Walker High School Wrestling Team.

He was the Regional and Alabama State wrestling Champion his junior and senior year at Walker, making him Walker's only 2 time Alabama State Wrestling Champion.

He had the distinction of losing only 3 matches in his entire career (2 his sophomore and 1 his junior year). He was also selected as the captain of the team his senior year. Because of his undefeated senior season, he was voted Best Wrestler in the state. His championship match was voted best match of the year, and he was selected to wrestle in an exhibition match at



the United States Olympics against Japan, possibly the most prestigious honor ever given a Walker athlete.

Bobby also played tailback on Walker's football team and was the smallest man to ever start at only 98 pounds and was one of the two strongest little men to ever play at Walker. After his career was over, he continued to officiate wrestling for a number of years. Bobby is also a member of the Walker High School Athletic Hall-of-Fame.

Bobby has four children: Bobby Colbert Jr. of Anniston, Barbara Daley, and Jerald and Jeremy Colbert of Jasper.
