


## JEFF TERRY

**J**EFF WAS BORN IN JASPER, ALABAMA ON OCTOBER 11, 1971 TO MOSES AND EVELYN

Terry. Jeff is the oldest of three siblings, Latonya Terry, Adrienne Terry and Shante Tabb. Jeff attended Dora High School where he played multiple sports but excelled at basketball. Jeff began his career on the Dora High School Varsity Basketball Team playing as a freshman for Coach Bill Griffin. Jeff was selected as the Most Valuable Player of the Walker County Basketball Tournament in 1988 and was selected to the Walker County All-Tournament teams in 1989 and 1990. Jeff was named on the Walker County All County teams in his junior and senior season. Jeff was selected as a First Team All-State Basketball Player by the Birmingham News and was also selected as an Honorable Mention All-State performer as well. In 1990, Jeff led the Dora High School Basketball Team to its first birth into the State Tournament since 1957.



In 1990, Jeff accepted a scholarship to play basketball for Coach Glen Clem at Walker College. Jeff set the tone for what was to come by scoring 34 points in his first college game.

Jeff was one of the leading scorers on the team as a freshman and led the team in scoring as a sophomore. He was selected to the Alabama Junior College Basketball All-Star Team and led the state in scoring for the majority of the season. At the peak of his sophomore season, Jeff was averaging over 27 points a game and led the team to the Alabama Junior College Northern Division Title. Jeff was selected as Most Valuable Player of the Alabama Junior College Northern Division in 1991 and was selected as an Honorable Mention All-American.

In 1992, Jeff accepted a Basketball Scholarship to Jacksonville State University where he was called the "Top Gun." He was selected as an All Gulf-South Conference Performer and upon completion of his career Jeff was third all-time in 3-point baskets made. At Jacksonville, Jeff played for legendary coach Bill Jones.

Jeff respectively gives much credit to his family, his teachers, his coaches and his teammates for providing him the guidance and support for any accomplishments he has achieved.

Jeff earned a Bachelor's of Science Degree from Jacksonville State University and Jeff is currently married to his soulmate Shemica Terry and they have two beautiful children, Chyna and Justus Terry.
